The bottom $1 / 3$ of the tree is secured to an adjacent metal bollard. | No - new installation | Parish Council to monitor and maintain precautions | From erection until removal |
| Contact with live electrics from lights on the tree | Passers by / visitors | The lights are IP65 rated for external use and connected to a 13 A fused 240 v supply with RCD protection from the adjacent streetlight. Access to the 240 v electrical supply is prevented by the bolted street light cover. | No - new installation | Parish Council to monitor and maintain precautions | From erection until removal |
