Chairman opened meeting at 7.30pm.

Declaration of Interest: There were none declared.

Public Participation: Pat Ling asked if the Village Hall hire fee for November's Table Top & Quiz Night could be donated to Children In Need and all Councillors agreed.

Minutes of meeting held on Tuesday 20th October 2015, after being circulated, were proposed as correct by Mr Eaton, seconded Mr Spurge, carried unanimously.

Progress Report:

Overgrown Hedge

An overgrown hedge in Stones Green was brought to our attention and this has been reported to Highways.

Footpath

The footpath between the Church and the burial ground is becoming overgrown so we have contacted Tendring District Council to find out if this work can be carried out by the Rangers Service.

Bench

It has been agreed to place a bench on the Triangle at Stones Green and a suitable one has been chosen; we are awaiting for a quote to install it from a local Contractor.

Street Lights

Having agreed to replace the oldest street lights in the Parish, our Contractor has been informed.

Village Hall Photos

Mr Daniels has taken photos of the Village Hall in preparation for the advert which will be placed in Coast to Coast.

Road Defects

The flooding outside Appletree Cottage has been reported to Highways. A pot hole in Stones Green has also been reported.

Road Gritting

A concern over road safety was raised due to the lack of road gritting in the winter through Stones Green so we have contacted Highways and the Bus Company but have had no response to date.

Telephone Box

The glazing panels need to be replaced on the Telephone Box in the High Street so Chairman will contact Mr Mayman, who has offered to assist with this project.

Highways:

Partridge Close

It has been reported to us that another branch has fallen from a tree at Partridge Close. This is a dead tree so we have asked our Contractor to take it down.

Mr Tierney brought to our attention a Public Meeting at Stanway Village Hall on 28th November to discuss the state of the roads and maintenance. He also mentioned the school sign on Wix Road is now upright.

Mrs Mason reported a pot hole opposite Myrtle Cottage and Mr Eaton reported the drain outside his property which is a source of considerable concern due to the high risk of flooding should it fail. These will be reported to Highways with a specific reference to the flooding risk and their liability should they fail to take action.

<u>Village Hall/New Village Hall</u>: There is no update regarding the New Village Hall. District Cllr Howard commented that both planning applications on Beaumont Road will have to go to the Planning Committee at Tendring District Council.

Public Rights of Way: There is nothing to report.

TDALC Report: The next meeting is on 25th November. Mr Tierney asked if there was anything of concern to us which he can raise at this meeting so we mentioned the condition of the roads and pot holes.

Planning: Nothing to report.
